

PETITION FOR A PUBLIC PARK AND BOAT LAUNCH AT ANCHOR REEF MARINA SITE

We the undersigned residents of Dover Township urge Mayor Paul Brush, Council President Gregory McGuckin, and the Dover Township Council, to work with County and State government to acquire and create a waterfront park, including a public boat launch, on the area known as "Anchor Reef Marina" at the southwest foot of the Seaside Bridge.

Since Dover Township, which is the seventh largest city in New Jersey and the Ocean County seat, currently has NO similar site suitable for launching boats, and few public sites where the public can enjoy fishing, crabbing, and relaxing by Barnegat Bay, we urge the Township NOT to allow ANY portion of this or adjacent sites to be commercially or residentially developed.
