PROPOSED EXTENSION OF WESTERN BLVD **FROM PINEWALD TO MOTOR ROAD**

How this affects you! By connecting Lacey Township with Pine Beach, this road would promote massive development at New Jersey Pulverizing site, (a.k.a. Fisher's pit) and Pinewald and dump tremendous additional traffic onto Route 9 between Pine Beach and Toms River.

Who's doing this? NJ Dept of Transportation, Ocean County Freeholders, and Berkeley Township plan to spend *four million* federal taxpayer dollars to free K. Hovnanian and other private developers from the expense of building the road.

The Constructive Alternative: (1) Don't build the Western Blvd extension for K Hovnanian. (2) Make intelligent changes to Route 9 at its many bottleneck intersections. (3) The NJ Pulverizing site should be restored and made into public open space.
